**The A12 London–Great Yarmouth Trunk Road
(A12/A14 Seven Hills Roundabout to South
of Bascule Bridge) Detrunking Order 2001**

Made - - - - *20th March 2001*
Coming into force - - *1st June 2001*

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980(1) and now vested in him(2) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf.

1. This Order may be cited as The A12 London–Great Yarmouth Trunk Road (A12/A14 Seven Hills Roundabout to South of Bascule Bridge) Detrunking Order 2001 and shall come into force on 1st June 2001.
