**The British Railways Board (Reduction  
of Membership) Order 2001**

*Made* - - - - *24th January 2001*

*Coming into force* - - *1st February 2001*

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions, in exercise of his powers under section 241(3) of the Transport Act 2000(1), hereby makes the following Order:—

**Citation and interpretation**

1. This Order may be cited as the British Railways Board (Reduction of Membership) Order 2001 and shall come into force on 1st February 2001.

**Membership of the British Railways Board**

2. The membership of the British Railways Board shall consist of a chairman and one or more other persons appointed by the Secretary of State.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

Under section 1(3) of the Transport Act 1962 the British Railways Board must consist of a chairman and not more than fifteen nor less than nine other members. This Order reduces the membership of the British Railways Board to a chairman and one or more other persons appointed by the Secretary of State.
