**The Education (Designated Institutions) (No. 2) Order 2001**

The Secretary of State for Education and Skills, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 129(1) of the Education Reform Act 1988(1) hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Education (Designated Institutions) (No. 2) Order 2001 and shall come into force on 1st August 2001.

2. The institution which is specified in the Schedule to this Order, being an institution which appears to the Secretary of State to fall within subsection (2) of section 129 of the Education Reform Act 1988, is hereby designated as an institution eligible to receive support from funds administered by the Higher Education Funding Council for England.
