**The Education (Student Support) (Dance and Drama)
(Amendment) Regulations 2001**

Made - - - - - 4th August 2001

Laid before Parliament 10th August 2001

Coming into force - - 1st September 2001

The Secretary of State for Education and Skills, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by sections 22(1) and (2), 42(6) and 43(1) of the Teaching and Higher Education Act 1998(a), hereby makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Education (Student Support) (Dance and Drama) (Amendment) Regulations 2001 and shall come into force on 1st September 2001.
2. The Education (Student Support) (Dance and Drama) Regulations 1999(b) shall be amended as follows.
3. In regulation 4(d)—
 - (a) in sub-paragraph (iii) for “College of the Royal Academy of Dancing” substitute “Royal Academy of Dance”(c); and
 - (b) delete “(vii) London Contemporary Dance School;”.
