The Social Security Fraud Act 2001 (Commencement No. 1) Order 2001

*Made - - - 26th September 2001* 

The Secretary of State for Work and Pensions, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 20(1) and (2) of the Social Security Fraud Act 2001(1) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

#### Citation and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Social Security Fraud Act 2001 (Commencement No. 1) Order 2001.
  - (2) In this Order references to "the Act" are to the Social Security Fraud Act 2001.

#### Appointed days

- **2.**—(1) The days appointed for the coming into force of section 16 of the Act (offence of failing to notify a change of circumstances)—
  - (a) for the purpose only of authorising the making of regulations is 26th September 2001; and
  - (b) for all other purposes is 18th October 2001.
