Satisfactory value for cultivation and use

Satisfactory value for cultivation and use

1.—(1) The value of a variety for cultivation or use shall be regarded as satisfactory if compared to other varieties accepted in a [^{F2}GB Variety List] its qualities taken as a whole offer, at least as far as production in any given region is concerned, a clear improvement either for cultivation or as regards the uses which can be made of the crops or the products derived from the crops.

(2) Where other superior characteristics are present individual inferior characteristics may be disregarded.]
