The Passenger Car (Fuel Consumption and CO2 Emissions Information) Regulations 2001

Dealers' duty in respect of a poster or display

- **8.**—(1) A dealer shall ensure that, in relation to each make of new passenger car displayed or offered for sale or lease to prospective end users by him at or through a point of sale, there is exhibited in a prominent position at that point of sale, a poster or display, which contains the official fuel consumption and official specific emissions of CO_2 figures for every model of that make.
 - (2) A poster or display for the purposes of paragraph (1)—
 - (a) shall comply with the requirements specified in Schedule 3; and
 - (b) shall be revised at least once every six months, and if any new model is to be displayed or offered for sale during the intervening period at or through a point of sale, the official fuel consumption and official specific emissions of CO₂ figures and the other requirements specified in Schedule 3 relating to that model shall be added to the poster.
