**DISTRESS, ENGLAND AND WALES**

**The Distress for Rent (Amendment) Rules 2001**

*Made* - - - - - *17th December 2001*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *1st April 2002*

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 8 of the Law of Distress Amendment Act 1888<sup>(1)</sup> and section 3 of the Law of Distress Amendment Act 1895<sup>(2)</sup>, hereby makes the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Distress for Rent (Amendment) Rules 2001 and shall come into force on 1st April 2002.
2. In Appendix 3 to the Distress for Rent Rules 1988<sup>(3)</sup>, the entries relating to Chepstow and Monmouth shall be deleted.
