**The A10 London–Cambridge–King’s Lynn Trunk Road
(M11 Junction 11 to A505 Royston Hertfordshire)
Detrunking Order 2001**

Made - - - - - *14th February 2001*

Coming into force - - *1st May 2001*

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf.

1. This Order may be cited as the A10 London–Cambridge–King’s Lynn Trunk Road (M11 Junction 11 to A505 Royston Hertfordshire) Detrunking Order 2001 and shall come into force on 1st May 2001.

2. In this Order—

- (i) “the plan” means the plan numbered L306GB/401/A10/5, marked “The A10 London–Cambridge–King’s Lynn Trunk Road (M11 Junction 11 to A505 Royston Hertfordshire) Detrunking Order 2001” signed by authority of the Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions and deposited at the Highways Agency, Room G44, St Christopher House, Southwark Street, London SE1 0TE;
- (ii) “principal road” as a classification for a highway, means that the highway is a principal road for the purposes of enactments and instruments which refer to highways classified as principal roads and is also classified for the purpose of every other enactment and instrument which refers to highways classified by the Secretary of State; and
- (iii) “the trunk road” means the A10 trunk road.

3. From the date when this Order comes into force the length of the trunk road described in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be a trunk road and shall be classified as a principal road.
