The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 38(8) of the Postal Services Act 2000(a) hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Postal Services Commission (Register) Order 2001 and shall come into force on 26th March 2001.

**Hours at which the register is to be open for inspection**

2. The contents of the register shall be available for inspection by the public between 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on every day other than a Saturday, a Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday or a day which is a bank holiday in England within the meaning of the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971(b).
