**The Newcastle upon Tyne Hospitals National Health  
Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 2001**

*Made* - - - - - *17th February 2001*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *2nd March 2001*

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 126(3) and (4) of the National Health Service Act 1977(a) and section 5(1) of the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after completion of the consultation prescribed under section 5(2) of the latter Act(c), hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Newcastle upon Tyne Hospitals National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 2001 and shall come into force on 2nd March 2001.

(2) In this Order, “the Order” means the Newcastle upon Tyne Hospitals National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Order 1998(d).

**Additional non-executive director**

2. In article 4 of the Order (directors of the trust), for “5 non-executive” there shall be substituted “6 non-executive”.
