The Social Security Amendment (Students and Income-related Benefits) Regulations 2002

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security Amendment (Students and Incomerelated Benefits) Regulations 2002 and shall come into force—
 - (a) for the purposes of this regulation and regulation 2, on 1st August 2002;
 - (b) for the purposes of regulations 3 to 6—
 - (i) in the case of a student whose period of study begins on or after 1st August 2002 but before 26th August 2002, on the day the period of study begins;
 - (ii) in any other case, on 26th August 2002.
