**The Education (Governors' Annual Reports) (England)
(Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2002**

Made - - - - - *28th August 2002*

Laid before Parliament *29th August 2002*

Coming into force - - *2nd October 2002*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by section 30(2) of the Education Act 2002(a), the Secretary of State for Education and Skills hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Education (Governors' Annual Reports) (England) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2002 and shall come into force on 2nd October 2002.

(2) In these Regulations, “the principal Regulations” means the Education (Governors' Annual Reports) (England) Regulations 1999(b).

Amendment of the principal Regulations

2. After regulation 3 of the principal Regulations the following regulation shall be inserted—

“3A. The governors' report may be combined with any other document whose preparation by the governing body is required by or under any enactment.”.
