Information to be included in applications for consent to market genetically modified organisms

PART I

General information

8. The proposed labelling, which must include, in a label or an accompanying document, at least in summarised form, a commercial name of the product, a statement that “This product contains genetically modified organisms”, the name of the genetically modified organism and the name and address of the person ^{F1}... who is responsible for marketing the product, and how to access the information in the publicly accessible part of the register.
