PART V

CONCLUSION

Transitional Provisions

18.—(1) Any claim made under the National Health Service (Travelling Expenses and Remission of Charges) Regulations 1988(1) which has not been determined before 6th October 2003 must be treated as if it were a claim under these Regulations and determined accordingly.

(2) A notice of entitlement to remission of a NHS charge or to payment of travelling expenses which has been issued under the National Health Service (Travelling Expenses and Remission of Charges) Regulations 1988 remains valid until its expiry in accordance with the provisions of those Regulations.

Repeals

19. The Regulations listed in column 1 of Schedule 2 are repealed to the extent indicated in column 2(2).
