# The Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003

### Enforcement – extension of Part V of the Data Protection Act 1998

- **31.**—(1) The provisions of Part V [FI and sections 55A to 55E] of the Data Protection Act 1998 and of Schedules 6 and 9 to that Act are extended for the purposes of these Regulations and, for those purposes, shall have effect subject to the modifications set out in Schedule 1.
- (2) In regulations 32 and 33, "enforcement functions" means the functions of the Information Commissioner under the provisions referred to in paragraph (1) as extended by that paragraph [F2 and the functions set out in regulations 31A and 31B].
  - (3) The provisions of this regulation are without prejudice to those of regulation 30.
