Citation and commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Police Appeals Tribunals (Amendment) Rules 2003 and shall come into force on 15th November 2003.

2.—(1) Rule 5 of the Police Appeals Tribunals Rules 1999(c) is amended as follows.

(2) In paragraph (1) after the words "section 50(3) of the Act" there is inserted "or section 81 of the Police Act 1997".
