The Renewable Energy Zone (Designation of Area) Order 2004

Made - - - - 13th October 2004

Laid before Parliament 25th October 2004

Coming into force - - 15th November 2004

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 13th day of October, 2004 Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 84(4) of the Energy Act 2004 (1) is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Renewable Energy Zone (Designation of Area) Order 2004, and shall come into force on 15 November 2004.

The rights to which section 84 of the Energy Act 2004 (exploitation of areas outside the territorial sea for energy production) applies shall be exercisable in those areas of the sea specified in the Schedule to the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution)(Limits) Regulations 1996 (2).

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order designates the area of the Renewable Energy Zone, an area of the sea, beyond the United Kingdom's territorial sea, which may be exploited for energy production. The Renewable Energy Zone will be co-extensive with the area within which the United Kingdom already exercises jurisdiction with respect to marine environmental matters, in accordance with Part XII of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea. The co-ordinates for the Renewable Energy Zone are those set out in the Schedule to the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution)(Limits) Regulations 1996, as amended by the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution)(Limits) Regulations 1997.
