**The Gangmasters (Licensing) Act 2004  
(Commencement No. 1) Order 2004**

**Provisions coming into force**

2. The following provisions of the 2004 Act are in force—
- (a) section 1 (establishing the Authority);
  - (b) section 2 (directions given to the Authority by the Secretary of State);
  - (c) section 3 (work to which the 2004 Act applies);
  - (d) section 4 (defining what is meant by “acting as a gangmaster”);
  - (e) section 5 (defining the territorial scope of application of the 2004 Act);
  - (f) section 6(2) (power to make regulations specifying when a licence is not required);
  - (g) section 10 (power to make regulations establishing an appeals process);
  - (h) section 25 (general provisions regarding regulations, rules and orders);
  - (i) section 26 (meaning of “worker”);
  - (j) section 28 (application of the 2004 Act to Northern Ireland) in so far as it relates to paragraphs 1 to 8, 11, 19 and 21 of Schedule 2;
  - (k) section 30 (short title and extent);
  - (l) Schedule 1 (consequential amendments); and
  - (m) paragraphs 1 to 8, 11, 19 and 21 of Schedule 2.
