**The Countryside and Rights of Way Act  
2000 (Commencement No. 4) Order 2004**

**Appointed day**

**2.** 13th February 2004 is the day appointed for the coming into force of the following provisions of the Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000—

- (a) section 63 (removal of obstructions from highways);
- (b) section 70(1) (minor amendment of section 66(3) of the 1980 Act relating to works for safeguarding persons using footpaths);
- (c) section 70(3) (minor amendment of section 300 of the 1980 Act relating to the right of local authorities to use vehicles and appliances on footways and bridleways);
- (d) the following provisions of Part 1 of Schedule 5 (amendments of Part III of the 1981 Act relating to definitive maps and statements and restricted byways)—
  - (i) paragraph 8 (consolidation of definitive maps and statements);
  - (ii) paragraph 10 (amendment of Schedule 14 to the 1981 Act relating to applications for certain orders under Part III of that Act);
  - (iii) paragraph 11 (amendment of Schedule 15 to the 1981 Act relating to the procedure in connection with certain orders under Part III of that Act); and
- (e) paragraph 3 of Schedule 6 (amendment of section 31 of the 1980 Act relating to dedication of way as highway presumed after public use for 20 years).
