**The Asylum and Immigration (Treatment of Claimants,
etc.) Act 2004 (Commencement No. 2) Order 2004**

Citation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Asylum and Immigration (Treatment of Claimants, etc.) Act 2004 (Commencement No. 2) Order 2004.

(2) In this Order “the 1999 Act” means the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999(1) and “the 2004 Act” means the Asylum and Immigration (Treatment of Claimants, etc.) Act 2004.

Commencement

2. The provisions of the 2004 Act specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall come into force on the date specified in column 2 of that Schedule, but where a particular purpose is specified in relation to any such provision in column 3 of that Schedule, the provisions concerned shall come into force on that date only for that purpose.

Modification

3. Section 9 of the 2004 Act shall, until the commencement of section 44 of the Nationality, Immigration and Asylum Act 2002(2), have effect as if the reference to section 94(3A) of the 1999 Act were a reference to section 94(5) of that Act.

Transitional provision

4. Notwithstanding the coming into force of section 9 of the 2004 Act, an appeal may be brought under section 103 of the 1999 Act against a decision if the letter giving notice of the decision is dated before 1st December 2004.
