The Leeds Teaching Hospitals National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 2004

Made - - - - 26th February 2004

Coming into force - - 8th March 2004

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 126(3) of the National Health Service Act 1977(a), and by section 5(1) of, and paragraph 3 of Schedule 2 to, the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. This Order may be cited as the Leeds Teaching Hospitals National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 2004 and shall come into force on 8th March 2004.

Increase in the number of non-executive directors of the trust

2. In article 4 of the Leeds Teaching Hospitals National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Order 1998(c) (directors of the trust) for "5 non-executive directors" substitute "7 non-executive directors".
