**The Tribunals and Inquiries (Dairy
Produce Quota Tribunal) Order 2004**

Made - - - - *4th March 2004*
Laid before Parliament *9th March 2004*

The Lord Chancellor and the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 13(1) and 13(5)(a) of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1992⁽¹⁾ hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Tribunals and Inquiries (Dairy Produce Quota Tribunal) Order 2004 and shall come into force on 31st March 2004.
2. In Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1992, for paragraph 13 substitute—

“**13.** The Dairy Produce Quota Tribunal for England and Wales reconstituted under regulation 7(1)(a) of the Dairy Produce Quotas (General Provisions) Regulations 2002⁽²⁾.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

The Dairy Produce Quotas (General Provisions) Regulations 2002 provide in particular for the reconstitution of and set out the procedure of, the Dairy Produce Quota Tribunals (regulation 7 and the Schedule).

This Order brings the Dairy Produce Quota Tribunal for England and Wales, under the supervision of the Council on Tribunals.
