**The Community Legal Service (Financial)
(Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2005**

Made - - - - 5th April 2005

Laid before Parliament 5th April 2005

Coming into force in accordance with regulation 1

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 7 of the Access to Justice Act 1999⁽¹⁾, and now vested in him⁽²⁾, makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Community Legal Service (Financial) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2005 and shall come into force forthwith.

2. In regulation 3 of the Community Legal Service (Financial) Regulations 2000⁽³⁾—

(a) in paragraph (1), at the end insert—

“;

(i) Legal Help or Legal Representation for a person who is subject to a control order, consisting of advice in connection with that order, help with an application to the Secretary of State under section 7(1) of the Prevention of Terrorism Act 2005⁽⁴⁾, or representation in control order proceedings”;

(b) in paragraph (2), after the definition of “Central Authority”, insert—

““control order” and “control order proceedings” have the same meanings as in the Prevention of Terrorism Act 2005;”.
