The Inquiries Act 2005 (Commencement) Order 2005

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 51 of the Inquiries Act 2005⁽¹⁾, having consulted the Scottish Ministers, the National Assembly for Wales and the Secretary of State for Northern Ireland in accordance with sections 45(3)⁽²⁾ and 51(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Inquiries Act 2005 (Commencement) Order 2005.

Commencement of the Inquiries Act 2005

2. The Inquiries Act 2005 shall come into force on 7 June 2005.
