MODIFICATIONS OF PUBLIC GENERAL ACTS

The Pensions (Increase) Act 1971

1. In paragraph 44 of Schedule 2 to the Pensions (Increase) Act 1971 (official pensions)(1) for “Scottish fire authority” substitute “relevant authority (as defined in section 6 of the [Fire \(Scotland\) Act 2005 \(asp 5\)](#))”.

The Road Traffic Act 1988

2. In section 85 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 (interpretation of Part 2), in the definition of “light passenger vehicle”(2) for the words from “a fire brigade” to “1947” substitute “any matter in relation to which a relevant authority (as defined in section 6 of the [Fire \(Scotland\) Act 2005 \(asp 5\)](#)) has functions (whoever uses it for those purposes)”.

The Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994

3. In Schedule 2 to the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994 (exempt vehicles) (3)–
- (a) in paragraph 4(2) (fire engines), for paragraph (b) substitute–
 - “(b) is used solely for purposes in relation to which a relevant authority (as defined in section 6 of the [Fire \(Scotland\) Act 2005 \(asp 5\)](#)) has functions (whoever uses it for those purposes).”; and
 - (b) in paragraph 5 (other vehicles kept by fire authorities)–
 - (i) for “fire authority” substitute “relevant authority (as defined in section 6 of the [Fire \(Scotland\) Act 2005 \(asp 5\)](#))”; and
 - (ii) for “fire brigade service” substitute “functions”.
