## The Transfer of Functions (Lord Chancellor and Secretary of State) Order 2005

## Transfer of functions to the Lord Chancellor

- **3.**—(1) The functions of the Secretary of State under the following enactments are transferred to the Lord Chancellor—
  - (a) the Legal Aid Act 1988(1);
  - (b) in the Courts and Legal Services Act 1990(2), sections 58, 58A and 58B;
  - (c) in the Access to Justice Act 1999(3), Parts 1 and 2, and Part 7 so far as relating to any provision of those Parts.
- (2) The functions of the Secretary of State under section 2(3)(a) of the Human Rights Act 1998(4), his functions under subsection (9)(a) of section 7 of that Act, and his functions under subsection (11) of that section by virtue of subsection (9)(a), are to be exercisable concurrently with the Lord Chancellor.
