Notice where person removed to hospital

- 11.3. Where a transfer direction has been given by the Secretary of State under section 47 or 48 of the Mental Health Act 1983(1) in respect of a person remanded in custody by a magistrates' court and, before the direction ceases to have effect, notice of transfer is given in respect of that person, the magistrates' court officer shall give notice thereof in writing—
 - (a) to the governor of the prison to which that person would have been committed by that court if he had been committed in custody for trial; and
 - (b) to the managers of the hospital where he is detained.
