The Pension Protection Fund (PPF Ombudsman) Order 2005

Remuneration, compensation, pension, allowances and reimbursement

2. The Secretary of State may—
- (a) pay to or in respect of the PPF Ombudsman, or a Deputy PPF Ombudsman ^{M1}, such amounts by way of remuneration, compensation for loss of office, pension and allowances, or make provision for any such payments, as the Secretary of State may determine; and
 - (b) reimburse the PPF Ombudsman, or a deputy PPF Ombudsman, in respect of any expenses incurred by him in the performance of his functions.
