PLACING ON THE MARKET AND PUTTING INTO USE OF MATERIAL MEASURES OF LENGTH

Requirements for placing on the market and putting into use

- **4.**—(1) No person shall place on the market or put into use a material measure of length unless the following requirements, or the corresponding requirements of the Directive as implemented under the law of another member State, are met—
 - (a) the measure is compliant with the essential requirements;
 - (b) the manufacturer has demonstrated its compliance with the essential requirements in accordance with regulation 5; and
 - (c) the measure has affixed to it the CE marking, the M marking and the identification number of the notified body which carried out the conformity assessment procedure in respect of the measure.
- (2) A person who fails to comply with the requirements of paragraph (1) shall be guilty of an offence and any material measure of length to which the offence relates shall be liable to be forfeited.
