**The Bus Lane Contraventions (Approved Local Authorities) (England) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 2006**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 144(3)(b) and (14) of the Transport Act 2000(1), makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Bus Lane Contraventions (Approved Local Authorities) (England) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 2006 and shall come into force on 4th July 2006.

**Specification of approved local authorities**

2.—(1) Derby City Council is specified as an approved local authority for the purposes of section 144 of the Transport Act 2000 (civil penalties for bus lane contraventions)(2).

(2) The Kirklees Metropolitan Borough Council is specified as an approved local authority for the purposes of section 144 of the Transport Act 2000 (civil penalties for bus lane contraventions)(3).

**Amendment to the Bus Lane Contraventions (Approved Local Authorities) (England) Order 2005**

3.—(1) The Schedule to the Bus Lane Contraventions (Approved Local Authorities) (England) Order 2005(4) shall be amended as set out in paragraph (2).

- (2) The Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (City of Derby) Order 2006 (S.I. 2006/1445) designates part of the City of Derby as a permitted and special parking area under paragraphs 1(1) and 2(1) of Schedule 3 to the Road Traffic Act 1991 (c. 40).
- (3) The Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Kirklees) Order 2006 (S.I. 2006/1446) designates part of the borough of Kirklees as a permitted and special parking area under paragraphs 1(1) and 2(1) of Schedule 3 to the Road Traffic Act 1991 (c. 40).
- (4) S.I. 2005/2755, to which there are no amendments relevant to this Order.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

The Bus Lane Contraventions (Penalty Charges, Adjudication and Enforcement) (England) Regulations 2005 (S.I. [2005/2757](#)), made under section 144 of the Transport Act 2000, provide for the enforcement of bus lane restrictions through the imposition, by approved local authorities, of penalty charges in respect of contraventions of such restrictions. This Order specifies Derby City Council (“Derby”) and the Kirklees Borough Council (“Kirklees”) as approved local authorities for these purposes.

The Order also makes a consequential amendment to the Bus Lane Contraventions (Approved Local Authorities) (England) Order 2005 (S.I. [2005/2755](#)) to add Derby and Kirklees to the list of approved local authorities set out in the Schedule to that Order.

No Regulatory Impact Assessment has been undertaken, since the Order is concerned with the enforcement of existing traffic restrictions and prohibitions and does not therefore constitute an additional burden on business. The costs incurred by local authorities undertaking enforcement are expected to be defrayed by penalty charge income.
