# The Medical Act 1983 (Amendment) and Miscellaneous Amendments Order 2006

## PART 9

Miscellaneous amendments in connection with revalidation

#### Second article amending section 29A of the Act

**65.** In section 29A(1) (regulations as to licence to practise and revalidation), in subsection (4) (d), after "licence to practise" add "whenever a licensing authority sees fit to do so".

### Amendment of section 29E of the Act

- 66. In section 29E(2), after subsection (2) insert the following subsection—
  - "(2A) Regulations under section 29A above may include provision for or in connection with requiring a medical practitioner to supply information to a licensing authority (including information about his prospective, current or past employment as a medical practitioner) which, in the opinion of the licensing authority, will assist it in determining when and how to revalidate him."

#### **Amendment of Schedule 3B to the Act**

**67.** In paragraph 3(2)(d) of Schedule 3B(3) (licence to practise and revalidation: appeals), omit "if the medical practitioner to whom the proceedings relate so requests".
