PART 9

Miscellaneous amendments in connection with revalidation

Second article amending section 29A of the Act

65. In section 29A(1) (regulations as to licence to practise and revalidation), in subsection (4) (d), after “licence to practise” add “whenever a licensing authority sees fit to do so”.

Amendment of section 29E of the Act

66. In section 29E(2), after subsection (2) insert the following subsection—

“(2A) Regulations under section 29A above may include provision for or in connection with requiring a medical practitioner to supply information to a licensing authority (including information about his prospective, current or past employment as a medical practitioner) which, in the opinion of the licensing authority, will assist it in determining when and how to revalidate him.”.

Amendment of Schedule 3B to the Act

67. In paragraph 3(2)(d) of Schedule 3B(3) (licence to practise and revalidation: appeals), omit “if the medical practitioner to whom the proceedings relate so requests”.
