**The Primary Care Trusts Establishment Orders (Amendment)
(England) Order 2006**

Made - - - - - *24th July 2006*

Coming into force - - - - - *1st October 2006*

The Secretary of State for Health makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 16A(1), (2) and (3) and section 126(3) and (4) of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 5A to, the National Health Service Act 1977(a).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Primary Care Trusts Establishment Orders (Amendment) (England) Order 2006 and shall come into force on 1st October 2006.

Amendment of Primary Care Trust establishment orders

2. For the contents of the Schedule (area of trust) to each of the Primary Care Trust establishment orders listed in column (1) of the Schedule to this Order there shall be substituted the words in the corresponding entry in column (2).

Revocation

3. The Southampton East Healthcare Primary Care Trust (Establishment) (Amendment) Order 2002(b) is revoked.

It does not change any of the areas for which the Primary Care Trusts were established.
