## The Gangmasters (Licensing) Act 2004 (Commencement No.3) Order 2006

## **Provisions coming into force**

- **2.** The following provisions of the Gangmasters (Licensing) Act 2004 come into force on 1st October 2006—
  - (a) section 6(1) (prohibition of unlicensed activities) for purposes related to work falling within section 3(1)(a) and (c).
  - (b) section 11 (register of licences);
  - (c) section 12 (offences: acting as a gangmaster, being in possession of false documents etc) for purposes related to work falling within section 3(1)(a) and (c);
  - (d) section 13(3) (power to make regulations as to what constitutes "reasonable steps");
  - (e) section 14 (offences: supplementary provisions);
  - (f) section 27 (exclusion of provisions relating to employment agencies and businesses) for purposes related to work falling within section 3(1)(a) and (c);
  - (g) section 28 (application of Act to Northern Ireland) in so far as it relates to paragraphs 12, 13, 14 and 20 of Schedule 2;
  - (h) paragraphs 12, 13 and 14 of Schedule 2;
  - (i) paragraph 20 of Schedule 2 for purposes related to work falling within section 3(1)(a) and (c).
