AMENDMENTS TO THE MEDICINES ACTS ETC.

PART 1

Consequential amendments to the Medicines Acts 1968 and 1971

The Medicines Act 1968

30. In section 58A (requirement to specify certain products for human use as prescription-only products)⁽¹⁾—

- (a) in subsection (1), omit “appropriate”;
- (b) in subsection (3), omit “appropriate”;
- (c) in subsection (4), omit “appropriate”; and
- (d) in subsection (5), omit “and section 58B of this Act”.

The heading of section 58A accordingly becomes “Requirement to specify certain products as prescription-only products”.
