**PART 2**

AMENDMENTS TO THE 1990 ACT

**Prohibitions in connection with embryos**

- 8.** In section 3 (prohibitions in connection with embryos), for subsection (1) substitute—
- “(1) No person shall bring about the creation of an embryo except in pursuance of a licence.
- (1A) No person shall keep or use an embryo except—
- (a) in pursuance of a licence, or
  - (b) in the case of—
    - (i) the keeping, without storage, of an embryo intended for human application,  
or
    - (ii) the processing, without storage, of such an embryo,  
in pursuance of a third party agreement.
- (1B) No person shall procure or distribute an embryo intended for human application except in pursuance of a licence or a third party agreement.”.
