The Local Access Forums (England) Regulations 2007

PART 4

Miscellaneous provisions

Matter as to which advice is to be provided

- 22.—(1) In this regulation—
 - (a) access to land by a person or persons will be for a "lawful" purpose on any occasion if he or they may access the land on that occasion without committing an offence or trespassing on the land; and
 - (b) "byway open to all traffic" has the meaning given by section 66(1) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981(1).
- (2) Subject to paragraph (3), the following is prescribed as an additional matter in respect of which it is the function of local access forums to advise—
 - "public access to land in the area for which a forum is established for any lawful purpose other than the purposes mentioned in section 94(4)"(2).
- (3) The function conferred by paragraph (2) is exercisable in relation to access by mechanically propelled vehicles only insofar as the access relates to byways open to all traffic.

⁽²⁾ The purposes mentioned in section 94(4) are the improvement of public access to land in the area for which the forum is established for the purposes of open-air recreation and the enjoyment of the area.
