**The Police and Justice Act 2006 (Commencement No.1,  
Transitional and Saving Provisions) (Amendment) Order 2007**

*Made - - - - 10th January 2007*

*Coming into force - - 15th January 2007*

The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 53(1) of the Police and Justice Act 2006<sup>(1)</sup>.

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Police and Justice Act 2006 (Commencement No.1, Transitional and Saving Provisions)(Amendment) Order 2007 and comes into force on 15th January 2007.

**2.** In sub-paragraph (k) of article 2 of the Police and Justice Act 2006 (Commencement No.1, Transitional and Saving Provisions) Order 2006<sup>(2)</sup> for “3, 4 and 61” substitute “3, 4, 9, 10, 61 and 62”.
