#### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Magistrates' Courts Warrants (Specification of Provisions) (Amendment) Order 2007 and shall come into force on 3 December 2007.

#### Amendment to the Magistrates' Courts Warrants (Specification of Provisions) Order 2000

**2.** In article 2 of the Magistrates' Courts Warrants (Specification of Provisions) Order 2000(**2**), after paragraph (e) insert—

"(ee) in the Criminal Justice Act 2003(**3**)—

(i) paragraph 7 of Schedule 8;

(ii) paragraph 8 of Schedule 8;"
