The National Health Service (Optical Charges and Payments) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 2007

The Secretary of State for Health makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 38, 78(1) and 126(4) of, and paragraphs 2 and 2A of Schedule 12 to, the National Health Service Act 1977(1).

Citation, commencement and application

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the National Health Service (Optical Charges and Payments) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 2007 and shall come into force on 14th December 2007.

(2) These Regulations apply in relation to England.

Paragraph 2A of Schedule 12 was inserted by paragraph 3 of Schedule 1 to the 1984 Act and amended by section 13 of the 1988 Act. The ophthalmic provisions of the 1977 Act will be repealed and replaced by the corresponding provisions of the National Health Service Act 2006 ("the 2006 Act") when the relevant provisions of the Health Act 2006 (c.28) come into force, but they have not yet done so - see section 277(3)(j) and (4) of the 2006 Act. As regards Wales, the functions of the Secretary of State under sections 29 and 126(4) of the 1977 Act are transferred to the National Assembly for Wales under article 2 of, and Schedule 1 to, the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999, S.I. 1999/672; section 68 of the 2001 Act provides that Schedule 1 shall be construed so as to include the amendments made by that Act to the 1977 Act; these Regulations therefore extend only to England.

Amendment of regulation 1 of the National Health Service (Optical Charges and Payments) Regulations 1997

2. In the definition of "NHS sight test fee" in regulation 1(2) of the National Health Service (Optical Charges and Payments) Regulations 1997(**2**)—

- (a) for "£52.04" substitute "£53.34"; and
- (b) for "£18.85" substitute "£19.32".
