**The Health and Safety (Fees) Regulations 2007**

**Date from which fees are payable under the Petroleum (Consolidation) Act 1928 and the Petroleum (Transfer of Licences) Act 1936**

**10.** Notwithstanding the provisions of section 4 of the Petroleum (Consolidation) Act 1928 <sup>M1</sup> or section 1(4) of the Petroleum (Transfer of Licences) Act 1936 <sup>M2</sup> the fees in respect of applications for petroleum licences prescribed by these Regulations shall be payable for any licence first having effect or any transfer or renewal of a licence first taking effect on or after the coming into force of these Regulations irrespective of the date of the application for that licence, transfer or renewal.
