

SCHEDULE 3

Transitional and Saving Provisions

Enterprise Act 2002 (Part 8 Domestic Infringements) Order 2003

11.—(1) This paragraph applies to an act or omission which immediately before the date on which these Regulations come into force is a domestic infringement under section 211 of the Enterprise Act 2002 in respect of the provisions of—

- (a) the Business Advertisements (Disclosure) Order 1977 ^{M1};
- (b) Part 3 of the Consumer Protection Act 1987 ^{M2};
- (c) Part III of the Consumer Protection (Northern Ireland) Order 1987;
- (d) the Consumer Transactions (Restrictions on Statements) Order 1976 ^{M3};
- (e) the Control of Misleading Advertisements Regulations 1988 ^{M4};
- (f) the Mock Auctions Act 1961 ^{M5};
- (g) section 29 of the Weights and Measures Act 1985 ^{M6};
- (h) Article 22(2) of the Weights and Measures (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 ^{M7}.

(2) Notwithstanding the omission of the references to these provisions in the Enterprise Act 2002 (Part 8 Domestic Infringements) Order 2003 ^{M8} by these Regulations an act or omission to which paragraph (1) applies shall continue to be a domestic infringement.
