The European Communities (Designation) (No. 2) Order 2008

Restrictions

6.—(1) Article 4 only designates the Welsh Ministers to make subordinate legislation that applies in relation to Wales.

(2) In paragraph (1), “Wales” has the meaning given by section 158(1) of the Government of Wales Act 2006⁽¹⁾.

(3) Paragraph (1) does not apply where the subordinate legislation is made jointly with a Minister of the Crown or government department other than a Northern Ireland Minister or Northern Ireland department.
