

## SCHEDULE 1

### MEANING OF HOUSEHOLDER

**2.—**(1) In relation to Scotland, householder means a person who is the owner or tenant of a dwelling.

(2) For the purposes of this paragraph—

- (a) “owner” includes any person who under the Land Clauses Acts<sup>(1)</sup> would be enabled to sell and convey land to promoters of an undertaking;
- (b) “tenant” includes a person who—
  - (i) is a service occupant;
  - (ii) has a licence to occupy a dwelling; or
  - (iii) is a cottar within the meaning of section 12(5) of the Crofters (Scotland) Act 1993<sup>(2)</sup>, and, in any case, a sub-tenant.
