

## SCHEDULE 2

### BENEFITS AND CREDITS

2. The benefits relevant for the purposes of paragraph (a) of the definition of the priority group in article 2 are—

- (a) council tax benefit<sup>(1)</sup>;
- (b) housing benefit;
- (c) income support;
- (d) an income-based jobseeker's allowance<sup>(2)</sup>;
- (e) an attendance allowance;
- (f) a disability living allowance<sup>(3)</sup>;
- (g) a war disablement pension which includes—
  - (i) a mobility supplement; or
  - (ii) a constant attendance allowance;
- (h) a disablement pension<sup>(4)</sup> which includes a constant attendance allowance; and
- (i) state pension credit<sup>(5)</sup>.

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(1) Council tax benefit, housing benefit and income support are provided for in Part VII of the 1992 Act.

(2) Jobseeker's allowance is provided for in Part I of the Jobseeker's Act 1995 (c.18); see in particular section 1(4) for a definition of "income-based jobseeker's allowance".

(3) Disability living allowance is provided for in Part III of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992 (c.4); see in particular section 71.

(4) Disablement pensions are provided for in Part V of the 1992 Act; see in particular section 103.

(5) State pension credit is provided for in the State Pension Credit Act 2002 (c.16).
