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SCHEDULE 2

BENEFITS AND CREDITS

- **2.** The benefits relevant for the purposes of paragraph (a) of the definition of the priority group in article 2 are—
 - (a) council tax benefit(1);
 - (b) housing benefit;
 - (c) income support;
 - (d) an income-based jobseeker's allowance(2);
 - (e) an attendance allowance;
 - (f) a disability living allowance(3);
 - (g) a war disablement pension which includes—
 - (i) a mobility supplement; or
 - (ii) a constant attendance allowance;
 - (h) a disablement pension(4) which includes a constant attendance allowance; and
 - (i) state pension credit(5).
