**The Safeguarding Vulnerable Groups Act 2006
(Prescribed Information) Regulations 2008**

Prescribed Details of convictions and cautions

12.—(1) The following details of relevant matter⁽¹⁾ relating to a person to whom paragraphs 1 to 5 or 7 to 11 of Schedule 3 to the Act apply are prescribed for the purposes of paragraph 19(1) (b) of Schedule 3 to the Act.

(2) A description of the offence committed by that person and the date on which the offence was committed and—

- (a) where P has been convicted of that offence, the date on which and the court at which P was convicted of that offence and the sentence imposed;
- (b) where P has been cautioned in relation to that offence, the date on which and place at which the caution was administered.

(1) “Relevant matter” is defined in paragraph 19(1)(b) of the Schedule to the Act by reference to section 113A [Police Act 1997](#) (c. 50).
