Amendments to the Civil Procedure Rules 1998

6. In rule 16.3—
- (a) for paragraph (2) substitute—
 - “(2) The claimant must, in the claim form, state—
 - (a) the amount of money claimed;
 - (b) that the claimant expects to recover—
 - (i) not more than £5,000;
 - (ii) more than £5,000 but not more than £25,000; or
 - (iii) more than £25,000; or
 - (c) that the claimant cannot say how much is likely to be recovered.”;
 - (b) in paragraph (3), for “he” substitute “the claimant”;
 - (c) in paragraph (4)—
 - (i) for “his” substitute “a”; and
 - (ii) in sub-paragraph (b) omit “financial”;
 - (d) in paragraph (5)(a), for “£15,000” substitute “£25,000”; and
 - (e) in paragraph (6)—
 - (i) for “how much he” substitute “how much the claimant”;
 - (ii) in sub-paragraph (a), for “he may recover” substitute “the court may make an award of”; and
 - (iii) in sub-paragraph (b) omit “against him”.
