The Kettering (Related Alterations) Order 2009

Made - - - - *16th October 2009*

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2) and (3)

Under section 92(2) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007(a) (“the 2007 Act”) Kettering Borough Council(b) made proposals to the Electoral Commission for the related alteration of the boundaries of county electoral divisions and district wards within the Council’s area.

The Electoral Commission have decided to give effect to the proposals and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 92(3) of the 2007 Act make the following Order;

Citation and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Kettering (Related Alterations) Order 2009.
- (2) This Order, with the exception of article 3, comes into force—
 - (a) for the purpose of proceedings preliminary or relating to the elections of councillors for district wards, on 15th October 2010;
 - (b) for all other purposes, on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2011.
- (3) Article 3 comes into force—
 - (a) for the purpose of proceedings preliminary or relating to the elections of councillors for county electoral divisions, on 15th October 2012;
 - (b) for all other purposes, on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2013.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“ordinary day of election of councillors” has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983(c); and

“the 2008 Order” means the Kettering (Parish) Order 2008(d).

Related alterations of county electoral division boundaries

3.—(1) Each area that ceased to be part of the parish of Weekley in consequence of the 2008 order ceases to be part of Kettering Rural county electoral division and becomes part of Brambleside county electoral division.

(2) In this article “county electoral division” means an electoral division established by the County of Northamptonshire (Electoral Changes) Order 2000(a).

Related alterations of district ward boundaries

4.—(1) Each area that ceased to be part of the parish of Weekley in consequence of the 2008 Order ceases to be part of Queen Eleanor and Buccleuch district ward and becomes part of Brambleside district ward.

(2) In this article “district ward” means a ward established by the Borough of Kettering (Electoral Changes) Order 2006(b).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect to proposals made by Kettering Borough Council to the Electoral Commission for related alterations of county electoral division and district ward boundaries. These alterations are related to parish boundary changes made by the Kettering (Parish) Order 2008.

The new boundaries apply in respect of district elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2011 and county elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2013.

Article 3 alters Brambleside and Kettering Rural county electoral divisions.

Article 4 alters Brambleside, and Queen Eleanor and Buccleuch district wards.
